Your legacy helps ACN do so much for the poor and suffering Church. In thanks for such a personal sacrifice, the Ukrainian Carmelite Nuns in Kiev, along with the chaplains of Aid to the Church in Need, will pray daily for the repose of the souls of our deceased benefactors.

Names of the faithful departed are added to the Carmelite community's *In Memoriam Book*, which rests in the abbey's Chapel, where the nuns gather for Holy Mass and daily prayers.



The community of the Discalced Carmelite nuns in Kiev take quite literally the words of Christ exhorting us to leave everything and follow him. They leave the "world" behind in order to seek Christ in the silence of contemplation, unconditionally entrusting themselves to his love and to the love of his Mother the Virgin Mary. Prayer and penance are their chosen path. Poverty, chastity and obedience are the preconditions for embarking upon this way. The true centre of their spirituality is their unconditional availability to God.

Since these contemplative sisters live a difficult life in their chosen cloistered state, they are particularly in need of help. ACN supports this community as well as many other contemplative religious communities throughout the world.



HOW YOU CAN HELP...

1. If you are making your Will and wish to leave a bequest to help the Church in need, you can use the following form of words:

I give the sum of \$...... free of any duties and taxes to Aid to the Church in Need ("the Charity") to be applied for the general purposes of the Charity. I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer of the Charity shall be a full discharge for the said Legacy.

2. If you have already made your Will but would like to change it to leave a share of the residue of your estate to the Church in Need, we suggest that you remake your Will. However, if you would like to leave a fixed sum, you can add a Codicil using the following wording:

AS WITNESS my nand this day of 20
SIGNED by the Testator/Testatrix
in our presence
and then by us in his/hers


You are recommended to ask for legal advice when drawing up your Will or Codicil.
